NEW COURSES

ECE 320 - Assessment in Early Childhood: Assessing the Whole Child This course focuses on early childhood assessment as a tool used to gather and provide educators, parents, and families with critical information about a child's development and growth. This course explores developmentally appropriate assessments for prekinder through 3rd grade students.

ECE 321 - Play & Creativity in Early Childhood Education (Course Lead: Thompson)

Because children are active learners, this course explores playful learning that helps children create meaning from relationships, the prepared environment, and their overall experiences. Students will gain understanding about the role of play and creativity in children's academic, social, and emotional learning and development. Relationships are key to creating safe, caring, and equitable communities in which children play in order to create themselves. Prerequisites: ECE 366.

ECE 322 - Family and Community Partnerships in Early Childhood Education This course explores best practices in building successful early childhood education programs through partnerships with children's families and communities. Students will learn about and understand the importance and complex characteristics of children's families and communities. Students will examine the role of home environments in children's development to support and engage families through respectful, reciprocal relationships that support and empower families. and that involves all families in their children's development and learning. Students will examine community resources that support young children's learning and development and to support children's families, and learn how to build connections between early learning settings, schools, and community organizations and agencies.
